INSTRUMENT OF GOVERNMENT – constituted under the School Governance
(Constitution) (England) Regulations 2012**

VOLUNTARY AIDED SCHOOLS

1. The name of the school is: **BRAMPTON ABBOTTS CHURCH OF ENGLAND PRIMARY SCHOOL**
2. The school is a voluntary aided school.
3. The name of the governing body is: **The Governing Body of Brampton Abbots Church of England Primary School**
4. The governing body shall consist of:
 - (a) **8** foundation governors
 - (b) **2** parent governors;
 - (c) The Headteacher
 - (d) **1** staff governor;
 - (e) **1** Local Authority Governor;
 - (f) **1** co-opted governor.
5. Total number of governors is **14**.
6. The term of office for all categories of governor is **FOUR** years.
7. There is a Trust Deed for the school named Brampton Abbots Trust Deed dated 24th September 1857 as amended by deed dated 16th October 1907.
8. **Appointment of Foundation Governors**

Foundation Governors will be appointed as follows:

- (i) **7** Representative governors appointed by Ross-on-Wye Parochial Church Council and the Rector acting jointly.
- (ii) Either:
 - (a) The holder of the following office shall be a foundation governor ex officio:

name of office: The Rector for the time being in the Parish of Ross-on-Wye

Or:

- (b) *The Archdeacon of Hereford* shall appoint a foundation governor to act in the place of the ex officio foundation governor whose governorship derives from the office named in (a) above, in the event that the ex officio foundation governor is unable or unwilling to act as a foundation governor, or has been removed from office under regulation 23(2) of the Regulations

9. **Ethos Statement**

"Recognising its historic foundation, the school will preserve and develop its religious character in accordance with the principles of the Church of England and in partnership with the Church at parish and diocesan level.

The school aims to serve its community by providing an education of the highest quality within the context of Christian belief and practice. It encourages an understanding of the meaning and significance of faith and promotes Christian values through the experience it offers to all its pupils".

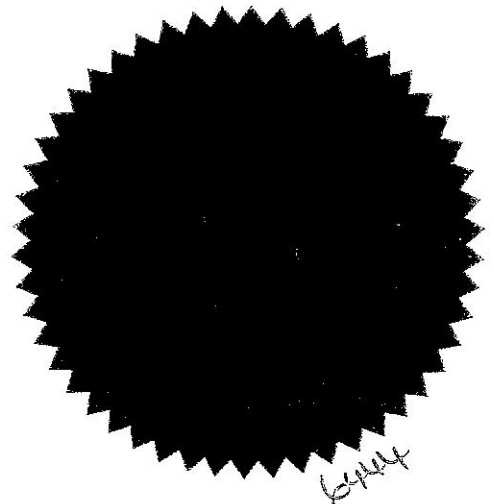
10. The instrument of government comes into effect on: **1st September 2015**
