Summary of PPG spending 2016/17

This year we have used the PPG funding for the following approaches to help meet the needs of our Pupil Premium children:

- Continuation of the Talk-4-Writing Project to develop Speaking & Listening across the curriculum.
- Enrichment Activities – school sport, trips and residential visits.
- Rapid Read – reading intervention programme targeting PP pupils.
- 123 Maths – maths, basic skills intervention targeting PP pupils.
- Y6 Booster Days – targeted work for individuals and small groups of PP pupils to support closing the gap.
- Additional SEN Coordinator time – to effectively target PP pupils and provide the best support for them.
- Improving the quality of pupil feedback – whole staff training
- Focussed LAC support – 1:1 and small group work.
- Specific targeted interventions (adjusted termly)
- Counselling – targeted at specific individuals (inc. PP)
- School Uniform Subsidy for all PP pupils.
