As part of our Outdoor Learning we will be developing our Geography skills through looking at aerial photographs to recognise landmarks and basic human and physical features within our local area. We will also devise a simple map and use and construct basic symbols in a key for emergency service

In P.E we are playing listening and movement games We will participate in team games, developing simple tactics for attacking and defending.

In History we will be looking at how Emergency service vehicles have changed over time. We will also learn about Florence Nightingale. We will also learn about Remembrance Day and Guy Fawkes. In Art we are going to be creating Bonfire crafts and using natural resources from out outdoor area to create Autumn/Winter pieces. In R.E we will be learning about 'Special places' and 'Special times' of the year. We will also be working on our Nativity performance.



In Maths YR will continue looking at numbers 1-10. Y1 will be focussing on addition and subtraction.

In music we are singing, learning songs and using instruments.

In English we will be listening and discussing stories linked to our Emergency Services.

In ICT we will use technology safely and respectfully. We will learn about being safe online. We will be learning about the technology used by the Emergency Services.

In Cooking we will be making some delicious recipes which include healthy fruit and vegetables.

In Science we will label the basic parts of the human body and say which part of the body is associated with each sense. We will observe changes across the four seasons with a focus on Winter.
