 correct person/people.
- **Newsletters** these will be written every two weeks and a digital copy emailed to all contacts. Please see the school office should you require a paper copy.
- Class Facebook Groups These have been set up for every class and parents/carers
 are asked to join these groups to keep in touch with class specific events. We ask that
 you minimise your use of Facebook messaging in these groups as it can lead to
 additional out of hours work for class teachers. See below for best form of direct
 communication with class teachers.

Secondary Communication (inc. updates on what has happened in school, special events etc)

- We use Facebook ('Brampton Abbotts Primary') to communicate things that happen across the school during the week.
- We also repeat messages sent via email and text to ensure the 'word gets out'.
- Please do not message the school through Facebook messenger as it is easy to miss messages sent in this way and it is not monitored closely during the school day.
